

Become a Club Member and Join Rotary!

Our club membership process is **easy**.

1. **Attend a Meeting.** Begin by being **our guest** at a regular weekly luncheon meeting. We meet on Tuesday with lunch at 12:00 and the meeting at 12:30 until 1:30pm. When you arrive, let us know that you are a guest (the first lunch of a prospective new member is free). We typically meet at the Nepean Sailing Club but check with our website to ensure location has not changed that week. Feel free to contact our Membership co-chair, Hugh Williams at hugh@rcwo.ca with any questions.
2. **Introduce yourself. Everyone is friendly and we'd love to meet you.** Let us know if you want to learn more about Rotary and our club's programs and initiatives. You will quickly discover that none of us are shy about talking about the work we do locally and internationally. Undoubtedly, you'll find a fit for your skills and interests.
3. **Apply for membership!** Once you decide that you would like to be a member of this club, **complete an application form** found on our website (rcwo.org) in the "Want to Join Rotary?" menu.
4. **Have an Interview.** Once we receive your membership application, the Membership Committee will review your application and will ask a club Past President to arrange a meeting with you to get to know you a little better, explain the various aspects and commitments you undertake when you become a Rotarian, and answer any questions you may have.
5. **Approval!** Your application is sent to the Board and then to the membership in general for its approval. Usually, this can be done quickly over email.

During this interview and review time you are **welcome to attend meetings and participate in any club projects** that might be happening.

Following approval, you pay your dues (pro-rated based on \$290 / year) to cover the costs associated with the club, Rotary District 7040, and Rotary International, and you are inducted as a new member of the Rotary Club of West Ottawa and of Rotary International.
